

ECRMC Mustang and All Ford Powered Show Judging Guidelines

1. All judges are expected to be courteous to all show participants at all times.
2. Judges are not permitted to touch a participant's vehicle without their permission.
3. Vehicles are to be displayed with hood, trunk/hatch open and windows at least ½ way down. No points will be awarded to these areas if closed and the owner is not present during judging.
4. Judges are not to discuss classing protests etc. with participants. These will be handled by tech personnel only.
5. All show vehicles are to be judged fairly, without bias or prejudice, judged on their own merits and not compared to other vehicles in their class.
6. Stand alone displays for show vehicles are discouraged and no points will be awarded for such displays.
7. All show vehicles will be judged for **cleanliness, attention to detail, neatness and quality of workmanship**.
8. Convertibles can be judged either top up or down. If up, the top will be awarded points in the "headliner" category of the interior section. If down, the top cover boot will be judged. If no boot is fitted, no points will be awarded.
9. All show vehicles with aftermarket window tint will have the tint judged accordingly under the "glass" category.
10. If headlight/tail light covers are installed, they will be judged accordingly under the "head and tail lights" category.
11. One bonus point will be awarded for a fire extinguisher **OR** first aid kit in vehicle. One bonus point will be awarded for original vehicle documentation such as window sticker, owner's manual etc.
12. There will be five judging categories (Interior, Engine compartment, Chassis, Body exterior, and trunk). Each category will have 6 areas to judge, with a maximum of 5 points in each area (30 points total per category). The maximum number of points for any vehicle, including bonus points, is 152. (see judging sheet)
13. If discrepancies arise, the head judge will make the decision. **The head judge's decision on any matter is final.**
